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## WHAT DO I NEED TO COMPLETE MY DACA APPLICATION?

- A cashier's check or money order for \$465 made out to *U.S. Department of Homeland Security*
- Two (2) passport-style photos (available at Walgreens, CVS and other locations)
- A list of the addresses where you have lived SINCE FIRST ENTERING the U.S.
- **Documents that prove you meet the DACA requirements, as listed in the chart below.**

Please note:

- Documents in a foreign language should be accompanied by a certified English translation - these translations can be done by anyone who is bilingual and signs an appropriate certification statement OR obtained at most currency exchanges and notaries.
- If you have been arrested or appeared in front of a judge for anything other than minor traffic violations you must obtain a copy of your criminal record and/or court disposition(s).

### Documents to Demonstrate You Meet the DACA Guidelines

Proof of identity and age	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Passport/Consular ID card</li> <li>• Birth certificate (with certified translation) AND a photo ID</li> <li>• School or military ID with photo</li> <li>• Any U.S. government immigration or other document bearing your name and photo</li> </ul>
Proof you came to U.S. before your 16th birthday	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Passport with admission stamp</li> <li>• If entered with a visa, bring your I-94</li> <li>• School records from the U.S.</li> <li>• Immigration documents</li> <li>• Plane or bus ticket when you entered the U.S.</li> <li>• Hospital or medical records</li> <li>• Religious records (confirmation, etc.)</li> </ul>
If you entered the U.S. legally, proof that your legal status expired as of June 15, 2012	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Form I-94/I-95/I-94W with authorized stay expiration date</li> <li>• Final order of exclusion/deportation/removal issued as of June 15, 2012</li> <li>• Documents related to deportation proceedings</li> </ul>
Proof of presence in U.S. on June 15, 2012 <i>(Note: if you have nothing dated June 15<sup>th</sup>, try to collect documents dated before and after the 15<sup>th</sup>)</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Rent receipts or utility bills</li> <li>• School records (letters, report cards, etc)</li> <li>• Military records (Form DD-214 or NGB Form 22)</li> <li>• Religious records (confirmation, etc.)</li> <li>• Copies of receipts for money sent (remittances)</li> <li>• Birth certificates of children born in the U.S.</li> <li>• Dated bank transactions</li> <li>• Automobile license receipts or registration</li> <li>• Deeds, mortgages, rental agreement contracts</li> <li>• Tax receipts, insurance policies</li> </ul>
Proof you continuously resided in U.S. since June 15, 2007 <i>(documents should show your name and be dated 2007 thru 2012 and to the present)</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• School records (transcripts, report cards, etc) from the school that you are currently attending in the United States showing the name(s) of the school(s) and periods of school attendance and the current educational or grade level</li> <li>• U.S. high school diploma or certificate of completion</li> <li>• U.S. GED certificate</li> <li>• Proof of enrollment in a GED class or vocational program</li> </ul>
Proof of your student status at the time of requesting consideration of deferred action for childhood arrivals	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• School records (transcripts, report cards, etc) from the school that you are currently attending in the United States showing the name(s) of the school(s) and periods of school attendance and the current educational or grade level</li> <li>• U.S. high school diploma or certificate of completion</li> <li>• U.S. GED certificate</li> <li>• Proof of enrollment in a GED class or vocational program</li> </ul>
Proof you are an honorably discharged veteran of the U.S. Armed Forces or the U.S. Coast Guard	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Form DD-214, Certificate of Release or Discharge from Active Duty</li> <li>• NGB Form 22, National Guard Report of Separation and Record of Service</li> </ul>
