Subject: Supplemental Information related with last week Shape files

Dear Bob:

As requested in one of your recent E-Mail, below please the information and clarifications requested related with the last Shape File provided for the Via Verde Project. The issues that will be addressed next week are the following:

Item Num. 1. Adjust the alignment at the Manati pineapple field strictly to follow a dirt road located therein. Shape File will be corrected accordingly for this pipeline segment.

Item Num. 2. At the Peñuelas Dry Limestone Area the RoW must be adjusted to 60 feet. Shape File will be corrected accordingly for this pipeline segment.

Item Num. 3. The Project alignment required to avoid the Forman property was further refined to place it over the mountain ridges to allow its construction. The re-alignments are very small and considered insignificant. Notwithstanding, it must be pointed out that conditions previously discussed as to the pre-construction field walk through to be carried out by the Resident Biologist will further address any additional protection approach required

Item Num. 4. Either fill the entire work pad at La Hermita de la Candelaria in Toa Baja to avoid any impact to the Archaeological site or move the exit pad further northeast toward the filled area. Shape File will be corrected accordingly for this pipeline segment.

Item Num. 5. The area illustrating the Archaeological Site nearby Rio Cocal as included in the Polygon map previously provided was greatly exaggerated as indicated during the various meetings held at the State Historic and Preservation Office. The new exit pad for this particular site is completely out side of the Archaeological site. In addition, the area where the pad will be located will be filled so the site will always be protected.

Item Num. 6. ALL Alignment Sheets showing any project adjustment must be updated. This will be provided by next week.

Item Num. 7 Wetland Impact Maps will be adjusted with the revised information in particular Maps #74, 77 & 2. (Maps delivered today)

Item Num. 8 In this regard, it must be pointed out that all the estimates of Wetland impacts presented by PREPA had been calculated at 60 feet. In addition, this figure is extremely conservative since the work to be realized in this area will be limited to the trench excavation as well as the placement of the extracted material at the site of the working trench. All excavated material will be transported outside of the area for needed disposal.
