Larry, regarding your inquiry on status of field site visits FOIA Exemption (b)(6) will be sending out a "meet me" location for Thursday, 2 June to get us started with field work continuing on Fri 3 June, Mon 6 June and Tue, 7 June, the latter probably a short day since the Corps needs some time internally before the PDT meeting next morning to discuss how the results to date are or are not informing the discussion on the type and quantity of compensatory mitigation. FOIA Exemption (b)(6) will also provide a schedule of dates for the following week(s). The "meet me" locations after 2 June will depend on the progress each day.

1. Within the enclosed Google Earth *kmz file is a subfolder called "Shortlist-for-2to7-June" that identifies 20 sites. The plan is to visit as many of these as possible of these on the days of 2, 3, 6 and 7 June. These sites were selected out of a draft list you provided (subfolder "DraftList-by-Jorge-Coll") by your email of May 17th, "UMAM sampling areas" and the sites identified by ourselves (subfolder "DraftList-by-FOIA Exemption (b)(6)" and referring to the Draft boundaries of the jurisdictional waters within the project corridor (subfolder "EmailPREPAenclosingJDshapefiles") provided by the May 13th email from Jousev Garcia, "Via Verde JD Shape files".

2. Some of the points in FOIA Exemption (b)(6) and Jorge's lists did not make the shortlist for a variety of reasons, for example in the location where is possible the applicant will be moving the pipe to the piperack and therefore no impact. We will re-look at these when we receive the final set of drawings showing the work areas.
